# High school graduation

This publication examines the individual, family, and school factors associated with obtaining (or not) a high school diploma 7 years after starting high school.

# Life satisfaction during the transition to adulthood

This publication describes levels of life satisfaction at age 19 and identifies key individual, family and social characteristics, and family situations perceived as stressful and their link with life satisfaction.
